MUDr. Juraj Payer, PhD., MPH, FRCP, FEFIM, the dean, hereby follows Act no. 552/2003 Coll. on work performance in the public interest and internal regulations of the Comenius University in Bratislava (from now on referred to as "CU") no. 19/2022 Principles of the selection procedure for filling the positions of university teachers, the positions of researchers, the positions of professors and associate professors, and the post of senior employees of Comenius University in Bratislava announces the opening of the following position:

### Expected workload:

As a head of IMBM, he/she is responsible for the management of IMBM tasks, duties, and research projects of the IMBM employees and students. IMBM is the only research institute of the Faculty of Medicine, CU. The focus of the institute, team members, technical equipment of laboratories, completed and ongoing research projects, and publication record of IMBM are listed on the website: <https://www.imbm.sk/>

The head of the department is responsible for the fulfillment of the established measurable indicators for IMBM: the minimum yearly requirements are 15 co-authored publications in research journals with impact factors covered by Web of Science for the whole institute, at the individual level at least 3 co-authored publications with a cumulative impact factor of 5, of which at least 1 publication as the first or last author.

- Vision of further development of IMBM taking into account the continuity of the ongoing projects and tasks
