LOGGING INTO THE AIS SYSTEM

Start your internet browser and type in the address bar <http://moja.uniba.sk> and then click on the **AIS** hyperlink. Click the button "Sign up".

You log into the **AIS** system using your **university login name** and password. 

After successful login, the main window of the AIS application will be available to you. *The Student Portal* provides simplified access to study data through selected panels. In the central part of the window, data about the student's current studies are directly available (*timetable, registration forms, final theses, ...*).



In the left part of the window, you can click to launch the AIS applications themselves (e.g. Overview of studies - VSES017), as we know them from the universal AIS interface.




Log in to the schedule in the **"My courses"** application.

In application **"My courses"** choose option  and the subjects of the registration form for the current academic year will be displayed. From the subjects of the enrollment sheet, select the subject to log in to the schedule and click on the icon .

The choices will appear: **"Registration for schedule"**, **"Unregister from schedule"** and next. Click on the choice , or click on the colored rectangle that tells about the scope of the teaching . If you are not signed in to the schedule, the color of the rectangle is red, if you are signed in to the schedule, the color of the rectangle is green, and gray is the color of the rectangle if it is no longer possible to sign in to the schedule.



After clicking on the choice Register for schedule the window *Registration for schedule* will open and the schedule actions of the selected subject will be displayed. Click on the icon  at the beginning of the line for the appropriate term ("Time and place"). **It is necessary to sign up for the schedule in the entire scope of the subject - that is, if the subject has a lecture and an exercise, you must sign up for both.** Confirm your choice of registration for the appointment with the button Save. If you do not want to confirm the selection, click the button Close.
