**Amendment No. 8 to Internal Regulation No. 17/2021**

**Directive of the Rector  
of Comenius University Bratislava  
determining the amount of tuition fees and fees  
associated with studies at  
Comenius University Bratislava**

**Year 2024**

In accordance with Article 65 (2) of Internal Regulation No. 5/2023 Statute of CU, as amended, the Rector of Comenius University Bratislava (hereinafter referred to as the "CU") hereby issues this Amendment No. 8 to Internal Regulation No. 17/2021 Directive of the Rector of Comenius University Bratislava determining the amount of tuition fees and fees associated with studies at Comenius University (hereinafter referred to as the "Directive").

## Art. I

The Directive is amended as follows:

1. In Article 4, third sentence, the following words shall be deleted: "who receives a scholarship from the scholarship programme established with the approval of the Government and to a student,".
2. In Article 4, a new fourth sentence is inserted after the third sentence to read as follows: "A student who receives a scholarship from the scholarship programme established with the approval of the Government is obliged to pay tuition fees for the study programmes listed in Annex No. 6.".

3. In Article 8, paragraph 2(h) reads:

"(h) is permanently caring for a child under the age of three years or a disabled child under the age of five years,".

4. In Article 8 (2) (h), the reference 10a is added above the word "years".

The footnote to reference 10a reads: "<sup>10a</sup>Section 99 (2) of the Higher Education Act.".

5. In Article 8 (8), the words "under paragraph 6" are replaced by the words "under paragraph 7".
6. Article 9 (5) reads as follows:

"(5) Excepting the instances in the following sentences, there is no legal entitlement to any reduction or waiver of tuition fees or deferral of tuition fee payment dates under Section 92 (18) first sentence of the Higher Education Act, even when a student meets the conditions for a reduction or waiver of tuition fees or deferral of tuition fee payment dates as defined herein, and provides all relevant proof and material. A student with specific needs who agrees to the assessment of his/her specific needs is entitled, according to the extent and type of specific need, to a tuition fee waiver in justified cases if the study is longer than the standard length of the relevant study programme.<sup>12</sup> The Rector shall always waive tuition fees pursuant to Article 2 (3) for the first academic year of exceeding the standard length of study if the obligation to pay tuition fees arose on account of pregnancy or on account of the permanent care of a child under the age of three or of a disabled child under the age of five.".

7. In Article 9 (5) last sentence, the reference 12a is added above the word "years".

The footnote to reference 12a reads: "<sup>12a</sup> Section 92 (18) second sentence of the Higher Education Act."

8. Article 13 (8) reads as follows:

"The following Annexes form part of this Directive:

9. After Annex No. 5, Annex No. 6 is inserted - List of study programmes at Comenius University Bratislava for which a student who receives a scholarship from the scholarship programme established with the approval of the Government is obliged to pay tuition fees."

## **Art. II**

This Amendment shall enter into force on the date of signature and become effective on 1 September 2024.
