Details of accommodation conditions for applicants with specific needs

1. If an applicant with specific needs requests accommodation for his personal assistant, he shall submit to the study department of the CU faculty no later than A4 of the schedule a valid opinion from the Office of Labour, Social Affairs and Family at the place of his permanent residence in accordance with § 15 of Act no. 447/2008 Coll., according to which the applicant is dependent on personal assistance. The report is submitted only once and is valid for accommodation in CU accommodation facilities for the entire period of the current study and for others without interruption of subsequent studies at CU faculties. An applicant with specific needs can request accommodation for only one assistant.
2. An applicant with specific needs who, according to § 22 of Act no. 447/2008 Coll. granted financial contribution for personal assistance in the scope of points 1 to 6 of Annex no. 4 of the said Act, is entitled to accommodation with a personal assistant of his choice. The assistant does not pay the price for accommodation. Such an assistant can also be a person who has no student or employment relationship with CU.
3. The assistant of another applicant with specific needs dependent on personal assistance, with the exception of a student according to point 2, is usually a student of the CU faculty who meets the criteria for the allocation of accommodation and pays the accommodation price for the accommodation. Such an assistant applies for the allocation of accommodation in the accommodation process.
4. As a rule, students of CU faculties with limited mobility and their assistants have priority for accommodation in barrier-free rooms and barrier-free apartments. In the case of a larger number of applicants with limited mobility, the assistants will be allocated accommodation near barrier-free spaces.
