

Scoring criteria of quality and social situation of the applicant

- 1) In the quality criterion (Article 12, paragraph 2, letter a) of the Directive, the continuing student receives points for study results based on the weighted study average as follows:
 - a) 700 points, if the GPA is 1.0,
 - b) in the interval 700 to 0, if the GPA is in the interval 1.0 to 3.0, expressed mathematically $((3.0 - \text{GPA}) / (3.0 - 1.0)) * 700$,
 - c) 0 points if GPA is greater than or equal to 3.0.

- 2) In the criterion of social situation (Article 12(2)(b) of the Directive), the continuing student receives points according to the amount of the social scholarship awarded by the CU faculty and paid in the month of May of the current academic year (hereinafter referred to as "SŠ") as follows:
 - a) 100 points, if the SŠ is at the maximum level of MaxSŠ,
 - b) in the interval of 1 to 100 points according to the height of SŠ, if SŠ is in the interval MinSŠ to MaxSŠ, mathematically expressed $1 + ((SŠ - \text{MinSŠ}) * (100 - 1)) / (\text{MaxSŠ} - 10)$,
 - c) 0 points if SŠ is less than MinSŠ.

MinSŠ and MaxSŠ values are part of the schedule.

- 3) The calculated point gain according to the individual points of this appendix is rounded according to the traditional rules of mathematical rounding to a whole number.
