Lucia Mokra is currently associate professor of International Law at the Comenius University in Bratislava. She is Dean of the Faculty of Social and Economic Sciences (2014-now).

Lucia Mokrá graduated in Political Science and Law. She had been awarded title „philosophiae doctor“ from Constitutional Law and associate professorship from International Law and European Law. She is serving as Dean of Faculty of Social and Economic Sciences of Comenius University in Bratislava. She is Rapporteur of Inter-governmental Council of UNESCO MOST programme and board member of TEPISA. She is national coordinator of RAUN programme for Slovakia.

She is author of many research work, papers and text-book. She authored several books for national and foreign editors and more the 100 articles, essays and chapters of books, leading international teams about international research projects. She is participating in many research projects focusing on European law from the institutional point of view, as well as from implementation practice. Her main research area are International Law, European Law, European Institutions, Human Rights and Humanitarian Law.

She has been actively involved in lecturing process at universities abroad (United Kingdom, Slovenia, Poland, Czech Republic and Italy), as she has a wide experience, teaching: Constitutional Law I., Constitutional Law II., Theory and Practice of Legislation, Constitutional Guarantees of Human Rights, Civil Society, Comparative Constitutional Law, Human Rights.

Prof. Mokra's research interests currently focus on International Law, EU Law (Institutions, Acts, Procedures), Human Rights, and International Organizations, and more specifically the relations between EU and International Organizations, and between EU and foreign countries. Very deeply analysed in her research activity is the the assessment of the compatibility of national rules with fundamental rights (as in the essays: *Internal dimension of human rights in EU Law*, *The Slovak Republic's positive obligation regarding human rights and against racial discrimination*, *European Values as a precondition of membership and their subsequent implementation*, *Religious values and the position of the basi Treaty with the Holy See in national law*).
