

## POSTDOCTORAL STUDENT GRANT EVALUATION CRITERIA (GUKPOST)

The application for a Postdoctoral Student Grant (GUKPOST) is part of the application for postdoctoral residency. The selection committee of the postdoctoral residency is also the evaluation committee of the GUKPOST application.

The selection committee of the postdoctoral stay (evaluation committee GUKPOST) consists of at least 3 members and is elected according to Internal Regulation No. 4/2024 Art. 3, par. 9.

In the selection procedure for postdoctoral residency, the selection committee assesses the application for postdoctoral residency for the period 2024-2025 in two parts:

Part 1 – the selection committee assesses the applicant's application for postdoctoral stay according to the selected criteria of the Faculty of CU / part of CU

Part 2 – The selection committee assesses the application for a postdoctoral student grant (GUKPOST) for the period 2024-2025 in three parts, the maximum evaluation is 100%. The individual parts of the grant are evaluated as follows:

- a) Topic of grant of postdoc – max 20 %
- b) project part of the postdoc's grant for the period 2024-2025 – max. 40 %
- c) financial part of the grant of the postdoc for the period 2024-2025 – max. 40 %

Verbal evaluation, maximum 10 lines.

The evaluation of the GUKPOST application is then entered by the selection committee into an electronic system published on the website at: <https://uniba.sk/veda/postdoktorandske-pobyty/grant-postdoktoranda-uk-gukpost/> together with the names of the members of the selection board. Only the chairman of the selection committee/supervisor of the postdoc has access to the system on behalf of all members.
